### Cost:

- ✿ **Grades K-12:** \$25.00\*per session (\*this group typically meets 2 sessions per week depending on school functions)

### How It works:

- ✿ Once registered, you will be billed for the sessions a month in advance via email.
- ✿ Tuition is due by the first day of the month.
- ✿ Payments are accepted online or can be sent into your child's school with checks payable to **Social Learning, LLC**
- ✿ Our Speech-Language Pathologist and/or Educational Specialist will complete an informal screening at your child's first session to develop a plan of care and goals for your child.
- ✿ Monthly summaries are sent home to all parents. K-12<sup>th</sup> grade students will receive progress notes each semester with their individual progress.

**Social Skill Development Checklist**

AGE 2-3	
	Plays mainly beside other children (parallel play), but is beginning to include other children, such as in chase games.
	Plays simple make-believe games
	Will answer simple questions (yes/no)
	Says sentences with 2 to 4 words
	Follows simple instructions (2-3 step)
	Copies others, especially adults and older children
	Takes turns with others
	Understands words like "in", "on", and "under"
Age 5-6	
	Associative and cooperative play with friends. Play has a shared purpose with friends.
	Will answer/ask "where", "when", "why", "how many", "what do you do?", "why do we?"
	Agrees to and follows rules in social interactions and in various settings
	Follows complex instructions (4-5 step)
	Sustains a topic for 4+ turns
	Uses such terms as, "thank you", "please", and "you're welcome" appropriately
Age 8-10	
	Identifies formal vs. informal people/situations (teachers vs. peers, school vs. home)
	Uses and understands figurative language (humor, idioms)
	Can problem solve with peers during a group/team activity
	Demonstrates good sportsmanship in competitive situations
	Can organize thoughts/materials needed to complete a task
	Can regulate emotions/ self in a variety of settings

Age 3-4	
	Role playing, temporarily assumes another's perspective-jokes with conversation partner, provides warning, teases (cooperative play skills)
	Would rather play with other children than alone
	Will answer/ask simple questions "what", "who", "where" (What is your name? "Where is the toy?)
	Makes appropriate eye contact when interacting
	Says sentences with 4+ words and can maintain a topic for 3 turns
	Follows simple instructions (3-4 step)
	Tells you what he/she thinks is going to happen next in a book
Age 6-8	
	Can engage in social interactions with peers in a variety of settings with ease
	Reads body language, facial expressions, and tone of voice in others
	State a variety of emotions (more than the Basic 4)
	Can make inferences and predictions
	Communicates cause-and-effect relationships
	Recognizes another's need for help and provides assistance
	Begins to understand and use abstract language
Age 10-14	
	Manages schedule and unexpected events and changes in routine.
	Can reflect on performance of given task and make modifications to procedure accordingly
	Can manage body and language during transitions between activities and during periods of waiting.
	Engages in small talk easily with peers and adults
	Attends to and accurately follow through with team building tasks
	Can take the perspective of others
