Fall Sports Agreement Packet C.B.A. Athletic Department

Dear Parents,

Welcome to the Chesapeake Bay Academy athletic program! Chesapeake Bay Academy offers many opportunities for students to participate in competitive sports and athletic clubs throughout the school year. Students ages 10+ before August 21st are eligible to participate (exceptions may apply and be made by the Athletic Director). Chesapeake Bay Academy will be competing in the Hampton Roads Athletic Conference for the 2018-2019 school year. The Athletic Department is going to set the standard for the improvement of our **student athletes**. Our goal for each member of our athletic teams is to have a great and fulfilling experience. We pride ourselves in making each team member a **better person, better student, and better athlete**.

We encourage students to participate, no matter their level of experience. The Athletic Director takes enrollment, participation, and level of experience into account when determining the teams that will be available each season. For some sports, participation is limited depending on the facilities and coaching staff available.

Athletic clubs may be offered during some seasons for students that may find it difficult to make the day to day schedule asked of participants in competitive sports. Athletic clubs, when available, are offered one or two days a week.

Please read the following for additional information regarding Chesapeake Bay Academy's Athletics and have **you and your student athlete** fill out and sign the attached parent and athlete agreements:

Medical History

Participants must have a valid Medical Physical Form on file with the Athletics Department. It must be **COMPLETELY** filled out by the parent (page 1 & 2) **as well as by the physician** (page 3), in order for your student to participate in any practices and/or games. This form must be updated **ANNUALLY** and will expire one year from the date of the physician's signature (page 3).

If a student is asthmatic and/or has allergies which would require the use of an EpiPen and/or an inhaler, we ask that an extra (EpiPen, inhaler, etc.) be brought to school to be kept in the team's first aid kit. Our goal is to keep our students athletes safe at all times.

Financial Requirements

- Parents will be assessed a fee for their students to participate in athletics; the rate will vary by season
Boys Soccer/ Girls Volleyball:
Volleyball \$150.00- Includes: Uniform (top/shorts), Transportation
Soccer \$175.00- Includes: Uniform (top/shorts/socks), Transportation, (Princess Anne Soccer Field Rental)
Spirit Club
\$10- Includes: Club T-shirt
- Parents attending games should be prepared to pay admissions for HOME games (\$3 – adults, \$2 – children) and at AWAY games as well

Transportation

- Chesapeake Bay Academy will be providing transportation for all student athletes to away games and parents/guardians will be responsible for transportation back to school and/or home
- If carpooling multiple students, parent drivers must supply an official driving record from the Department of Motor Vehicles as well as a verification of Auto Insurance
 - In order to ride home with another parent/guardian, written permission must be given to the Athletic Director from both students' parents
- A list of all people who are authorized to pick up your student must be submitted to the Athletic Department
 - This is different from the authorized list that the school office has. It is for the Athletic Department only.

Coaches

Coaches will work with all players to improve skills and teach them teamwork, sportsmanship, and leadership. Coaches do their best to involve all players in games but playing time is not guaranteed. Playing time and all aspects on the field will be solely controlled by the Head Coach. The Athletic Director and/or the Athletic Coordinator do not have authority over playing time.

Positive communication between coaches, parents and student athletes is key to building a strong athletic program. Due to privacy issues, concerns should not be publically discussed with coaches before, during, or after practices and games. Please contact the Athletic Director to arrange a meeting with the coach and/or Athletic Director to discuss these issues. The Athletic Department will do anything and everything to help the experience for our student athletes and for the overall Chesapeake Bay Academy program.

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Student Participation Contract **C.B.A. Athletic Department**

Please review this contract with your student and return it to the Athletic Department

Section I: Academics and School Conduct

Academic and/or behavioral issues during school which results in detentions or homework center (HWC) due to a missing homework assignment(s) will result in disciplinary actions for sports.

- *Upper School Students*

Students must remain in good academic standing and maintain a “C” average or better in each class on progress reports and report cards

- *Middle School Students*

Students must remain in good academic standing and maintain “C” average or better in each class for progress reports and report cards

(Please see the Student Handbook for further details)

The 1st detention/HWC a student-athlete receives will be considered a warning. After the 1st detention/HWC, there may be additional consequences at practice, missing game time, or an entire game. All situations will be handled on an individual basis and will reflect the severity of the behavior and repetitiveness of inappropriate behaviors.

- *School Attendance*

In order to participate in a practice and/or game, student athletes must report to Chesapeake Bay Academy for school no later than 12:00pm. Students must remain in attendance for three (3) hours of the school day in order to play that day. Exceptions must be authorized by the Athletic Director.

Section II: Misbehavior at Practice and/or Games

Disruptiveness, disrespect or any other negative representation of Chesapeake Bay Academy at practice, games or within the community is not tolerated and may warrant disciplinary actions discussed in Section I. Being a representative of our school is a privilege and we must respect our school, coaches, and teammates.

Section III: Personal Belongings

Personal belongings including but not limited to cell phones, iPods, electronics, etc. are the responsibility of the student-athlete. It is the participant’s responsibility to ensure that all items are kept safe and secure during practices and games. Chesapeake Bay Academy is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

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Parental/Guardian Agreement C.B.A. Athletic Department

Section I: Fees/Billing

Cost of participation varies for each. The fee helps cover the cost of conference fees, coaches, referees, facilities, and end of season banquets. Additional costs may include purchase of items that will not be returned to the Athletic Department (shoes, socks, etc.). This fee will be made known to Parents/Guardians of the athlete prior to the start of the season.

Accounts will be billed after the first game. No refund will be issued should a player get dismissed from the team due to a contract violation and/or any other inappropriate behavior.

Student accounts may also be charged a late fee of \$10.00 if a student is picked up later than 15 minutes after a practice or game.

Section II: Uniforms

Uniforms are issued at the beginning of the season. Athletes will sign out the uniform once distributed. Uniforms need to be returned at the end of the season. Lost or damaged uniforms will result in a charge of up to \$75.00, which will go towards the replacement of the uniform.
